

STARS Awards

The **Student Training and Recognition Awards** help student groups grow in line with LSESU values. They offer **official recognition** for your Club or Society's achievements and can attract new members, guest speakers, and sponsors by showcasing your group's **high standards** and **activity**.

There are **10 badges** available. Clubs & Societies must complete the **basic requirements** before unlocking the badges.

How to complete a badge submission?

1 Complete the basic requirements checklist.

- See the next page.

2 Download & fill out the badge submission document.

- Write a description of how your group has achieved the criteria (100 words max. per box)
- Attach evidence to support your description.
 - E.g. photos, screenshots, social media posts, advertisements etc.

3 Attach the document & submit the form for approval!

- The Sports and Societies Teams will be in contact in June regarding the outcome of your STARS applications!



Top Tips!

- Delegate & spread out badge submissions to different committee members!
- Start planning the STARS badges as early as possible – don't leave it all last minute!
- Create a timeline of events and highlight key STARS areas!
- Write clear and concise descriptions – there's only 100 words!

Basics requirements checklist

All Clubs and Societies must complete the basic requirements checklist. This must be completed before badges are submitted.

✓ **All core committee members have received admin rights.**

✓ **Submit your group's Constitution.**

✓ **Have an up-to-date LSESU webpage**

- Include the following subheadings: “About Us”, “Memberships”, “Events & Activities” & “Contact Us”.

✓ **Demonstrate your group’s affiliation with LSESU by:**

- Following @lsesu on Instagram
- Tagging @lsesu in your group’s Instagram bio.

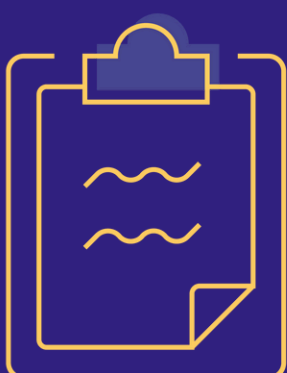
✓ **Run a stall at the Welcome Fair.**

- Doesn’t apply to new groups

✓ **Run a GIAG session**

✓ **At least 20 members have purchased a membership**

- 10 members for a National/Cultural Society



If this has not been completed, all your badge submissions will be not be approved!

Campaigning Badge



This badge recognises Clubs/Societies that champion student voices and drive positive change by engaging with SU campaigns, whether by leading their own, supporting existing initiatives, or keeping their members informed and involved.

Complete ONE of the following:

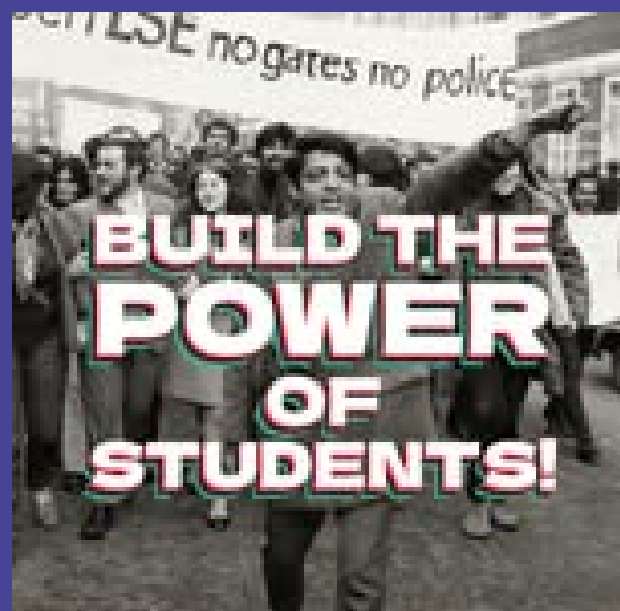

Charitable Badge

Complete TWO of the following:

Organise at least one fundraising event or fundraiser for a charity

There are 2 main options:

1. Reach out to RAG to support on organising a fundraising event (rag@lsesu.org)
2. Book a Sheffield Street Stall to fundraise for a charity.

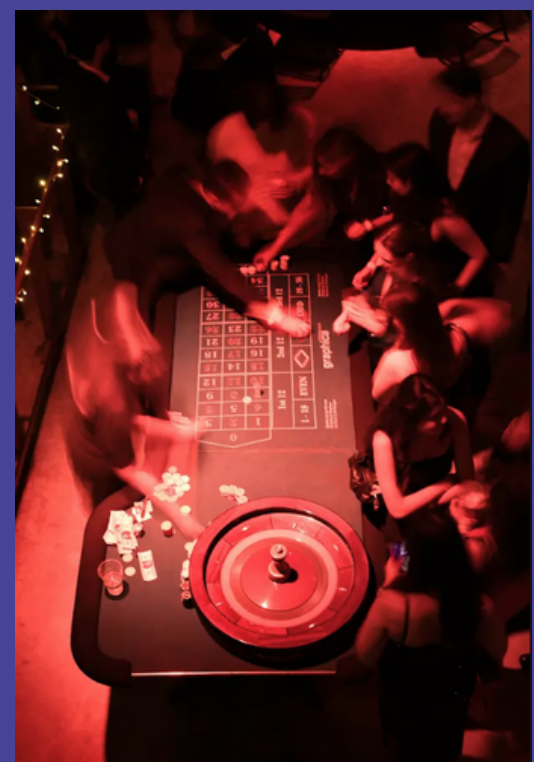


Run a volunteering session as a Club/Society through the LSE Volunteer Centre.

Community Badge



This badge recognises Clubs/Societies that build a strong sense of community through regular events, membership growth, alumni engagement, and member recognition.

Complete TWO of the following:

Facilitate at least two alumni engagement opportunities that connect current members with alumni.

Host at least one social event per month from 1st October to 31st March, include at least two non-drinking socials.

- Examples include movie nights, board games, crafts, workshops etc.

Increase membership by 10% compared to the previous academic year.

Democracy Badge



This badge recognises Clubs/Societies that demonstrate fair and inclusive governance through contested elections, a Wellbeing Officer role, a formal AGM, and strong member participation

Complete TWO of the following:

All core committee positions have at least one candidate standing for election.

- Spring Elections will come quick! Start spreading the word and recruiting early!

Engagement Badge



This badge is awarded to Clubs/Societies who have engaged with the SU in developing their society, by attending drop-ins and forums, the Student Leaders Conference, or submitting a feedback form.

Complete TWO of the following:

Submit a termly SU feedback form (by the end of Dec & March).

Inclusion Badge

Introduce a buddy or peer-mentoring scheme in your group with a focus on inclusion and community building (rather than professional develop

- Design an internal peer-scheme to connect your members with one another. This should develop a sense of belonging and community.

Social Media Badge

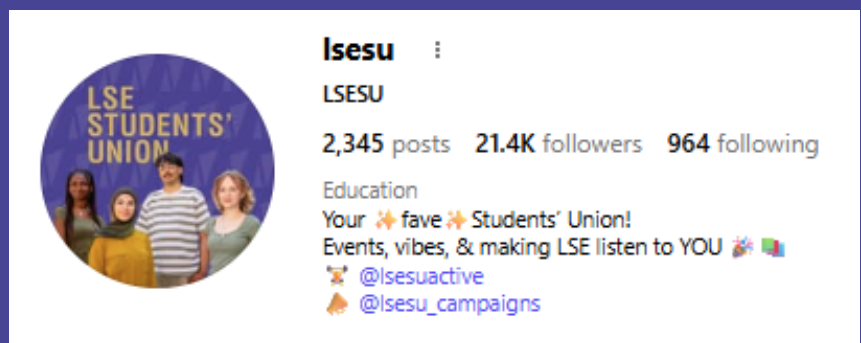


This badge recognises Clubs/Societies that actively promote themselves and amplify SU campaigns through engaging video content and social media collaboration.

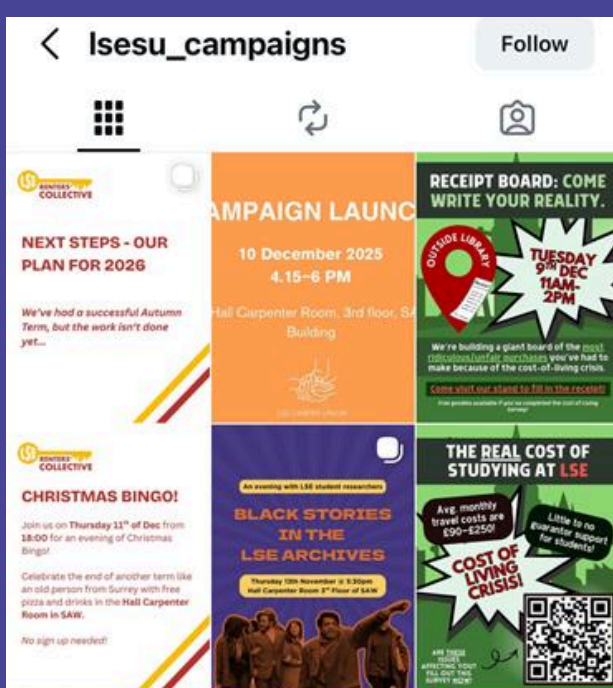
Complete TWO of the following:

Create a promotional video/reel of your group and post on social media.

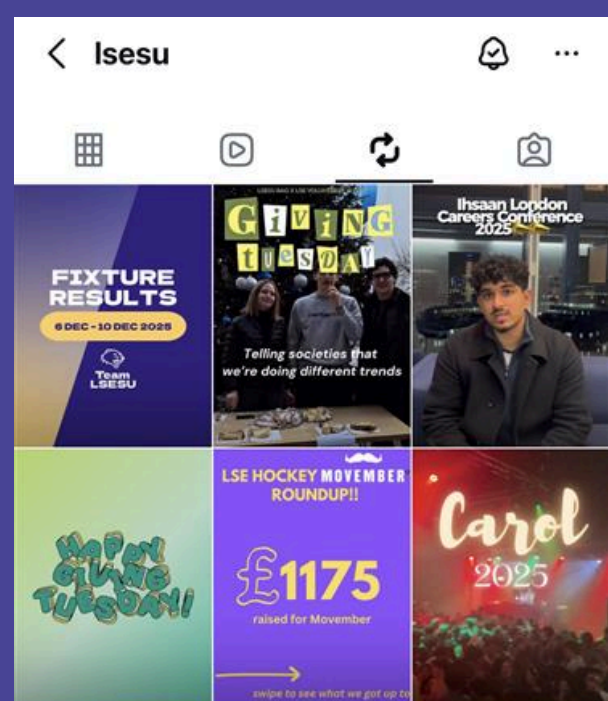
