



Online Elections Rules for Club and Society Committee Candidates

- No Candidates are permitted to use the Club or Society members list to promote their individual manifesto or campaign for votes.
- Committee can support candidates with promoting all candidates and materials via email.
- All Candidates can submit a photo and manifesto at the time of their nomination.
- All manifestos will be reviewed by staff, and once approved will be published. Candidates are expected to ensure that the following is **not included**:
 - Personal contact information.
 - Derogatory comments about other candidates.
- If a group runs a hustings** all candidates must be given the opportunity to speak, and for the same amount of time.
- If a candidate is unable to attend the hustings, they may submit a speech to be read out on their behalf.
- Candidates are not permitted to have any budget or expenditure for the purpose of campaigning or creating promotional materials.
- All elections that are run online are subject to approval by the Returning Officer. The Returning Officer for Club and Society elections is the Activities and Development Officer.

****What is Hustings?**

Hustings is the event whereby any candidate who is nominated for an election will get the chance to present their manifestos and answer any questions your members may have. How groups support the candidates in their opportunity to campaign to your members is up to the committee and members. If your group has not yet confirmed one, you can request that they do so.
