### What does the Democracy Committee do?

The Democracy Committee:

- Ensures that LSESU functions in a democratic way, in according with the Constitution
- Agrees dates, rules and regulations pertaining to elections and referenda
- Assists with promoting elections, Union General Meetings and other democratic structures
- Attends short meetings (approximately half an hour) every week to scrutinise and approve motions. UGM
- Attends all Union General Meetings
