

# Raising & Giving (RAG) President

## What does the RAG President do?

The RAG President:

- Facilitates and support student fundraising within LSESU by leading RAG
- Facilitates events such as Freshers' Week events, RAG Band, Welcome Ball and the Postgraduate Ball as well as challenges such as the Mount Kilimanjaro trek
- Manages a committee of student volunteers
- Acts as the main point of contact for charities looking to fundraise with LSESU
- Provides support to any LSE student who is undertaking fundraising for a charitable cause
- Takes the lead on organising RAG Week
- Attends regular 121s with relevant LSESU staff, and remain in regular contact through email/phone between meetings
- Attends approximately six Executive meetings and the weekly UGMs, or send official apologies if this is not possible
- Communicates and collaborate with the Sabbatical Officers where necessary
- Communicates your work to students both in person and online

## You should nominate yourself if you...

- Have participated in RAG events and challenges
- Have an interest in/understanding of the third sector, fundraising and volunteering
- Have excellent time management and organisational skills
- Have excellent communication and negotiation skills
- Have experience of organising events

**You must be a member of RAG to run for this position**

**It is strongly advisable to have held a substantial committee position within RAG, and to have demonstrated a considerable commitment to RAG throughout your time at LSE**
