What does the Trustee Board do?

- Ensure that everything LSESU does benefits students
- Ensure that LSESU remains in good financial shape, including approving the annual budget
- Ensure that LSESU does not break any laws or regulations
- Interpret the Constitution, Articles and Byelaws
- Attend all Trustee Board meetings
- Read relevant reports and papers prior to meetings

You should nominate yourself if ...

- You want to help shape the future of LSESU
- You're thinking of running for a Part-time Officer or Sabbatical Officer position in the future. This is a great way to try out campaigning and to convince students you can represent their views
- Want to gain experience working in the third sector

Due to Charity Law, the following are requirements for anyone wishing to be a trustee:

- You cannot have been convicted of an offence involving deception or dishonesty (unless the conviction is spent)
- You cannot have a history of bankruptcy
