What is the LSESU Trustee Board?

LSE Students' Union is a charity and a company, so our Trustee Board has overall responsibility for the legal, strategic and financial health of the Students' Union. This means that it is the ultimate decision-maker and has the ultimate responsibility for all the organisations' activities. Some examples of what the Trustee Board is responsible for include setting targets that are included in our strategic plan and approving areas of expansion for the SU.

The Trustee Board consists of five Sabbatical Officers, six students and one non-student appointed by the Trustees themselves. Students on the Trustee Board will serve a one year term.

What you will do in the role

- Attend Trustee Board meetings twice a term, representing the views of all SU members at these meetings.
- Prepare for the meetings by coming to briefing sessions put on by the SU, reading the relevant reports and papers and consulting with students on the issues they care about.
- Following up by helping the SU implement change and reporting back to students.

- You are passionate about improving the work that the SU does and ensuring our strategic and financial decisions benefit all students.
- You want a flexible leadership role that you can fit around your studies and other commitments.
- You wish to gain experience in financial and legal oversight, working in an executive capacity.
- You want to improve your CV.
