06/02/2019	A complaint was received alleging the Labour Society was holding an election for early endorsement of candidates.	The Returning Officer investigated this complaint and found the society was holding a vote on another election. Therefore the complaint was <u>not upheld</u> .
04/03/2019	This complaint alleged Will Stein's campaign was contacting individuals before announcement of candidacy.	The investigation by Returning Officer, the complaint was <u>upheld</u> .
05/03/2019	This complaint alleged Will Stein's campaign was contacting individuals before announcement of candidacy	Alongside the other complaint alleging early announcement of candidacy, this complaint was <u>upheld</u> . A sanction was given to the candidate of a full 1 hour campaign ban and a warning issued.
05/03/2019	A complaint alleged that Will Stein's campaign team contacting club and society members and was offering processo for involvement in his campaign	After investigation into the evidence, this complaint was <u>not upheld</u> , but a warning was issued.
07/03/2019	A complaint was received that Sadia had released an instagram post about her campaign before the official announcement of candidates.	After investigation by the returning officer, this complaint was <u>upheld</u> . The candidate was told to remove posts and a warning was issued by the returning officer.
15/03/2019	A complaint was received alleging Will Stein's campaign had contacted societies regarding campaign policies before the official announcement of candidacy. Contacting clubs and societies before announcement of candidacy	After investigation by the returning officer, this complaint was <u>upheld</u> . A sanction was given by the returning officer of a full 2 hour campaign ban
18/03/2019	A complaint was received that alleged Harry Compton's campaign posted about their campaign in a closed society group.	After investigation, this complaint was <u>upheld</u> by the returning officer. To rectify fairness, the candidate was told to post a reminder of other candidates in the elections, and a warning issued
19/03/2019	The returning officer received a complaint that the Grimshaw Society unofficially endorsed a candidate	After investigation by the returning officer, this complaint was <u>not upheld</u> as the society met all requirements to endorse.
