



Beyond the Classroom: Project Management

Continuing our busy start to term, Beyond the Classroom: Project Management provided students with practical advice in the organisation and management of large scale projects.

The session outlined the 5 key stages of project management: project conception and initiation, planning, implementation, monitoring and control and project close - with a focus on the latter four.



The session engaged with student leaders, asking them to apply techniques covered in the session to their own projects. Project leaders worked in small groups to apply techniques such as identifying objectives and risks to their own activities.

Students applied troubleshooting techniques to scenarios they could potentially encounter while managing a project - looking at the outcomes of compromising on time, quality or cost.
